Grass Roots After School Soccer Program (GRASSP) is excited to offer an after-school soccer program for girls and boys grades 6-8. The program uses the sport of soccer to teach personal responsibility, work ethic, teamwork and good decision making to understand the importance of an education and to become connected at home and with the school.



Capital Futbol Club (CFC), Salem Leadership Foundation (SLF), and Salem-Keizer's six local high school soccer programs are collaborating to provide a **free** soccer program to middle school students starting **April 3rd**. Coaches from each Salem-Keizer high school will connect with the middle schools and oversee the weekly training sessions. CCMS will offer a girls team and a boys team that participates in two jamborees this spring **April 28** and **May 19**. The roster for the Jamborees will be set at 20, but the weekly training sessions can exceed 20. Track and Field athletes are eligible to participate in GRASSP if the practice schedule does not conflict. CCMS GRASSP program will start after school the week of April 3rd, 2023.
